Interns should expect to work outside in all weather conditions including cold temperatures, rain, and daily summer heat/humidity of 90-100 degrees. Applicants must also have a valid driver's license. While previous farming experience is preferred it is not required, however it is essential that candidates are committed to the farming lifestyle and all that it demands. The internship position is a working/learning experience that should be beneficial to you as an intern and assist in making the farm successful. Finding a good match between what our farm can offer and the needs and expectations of an intern are incredibly important.
